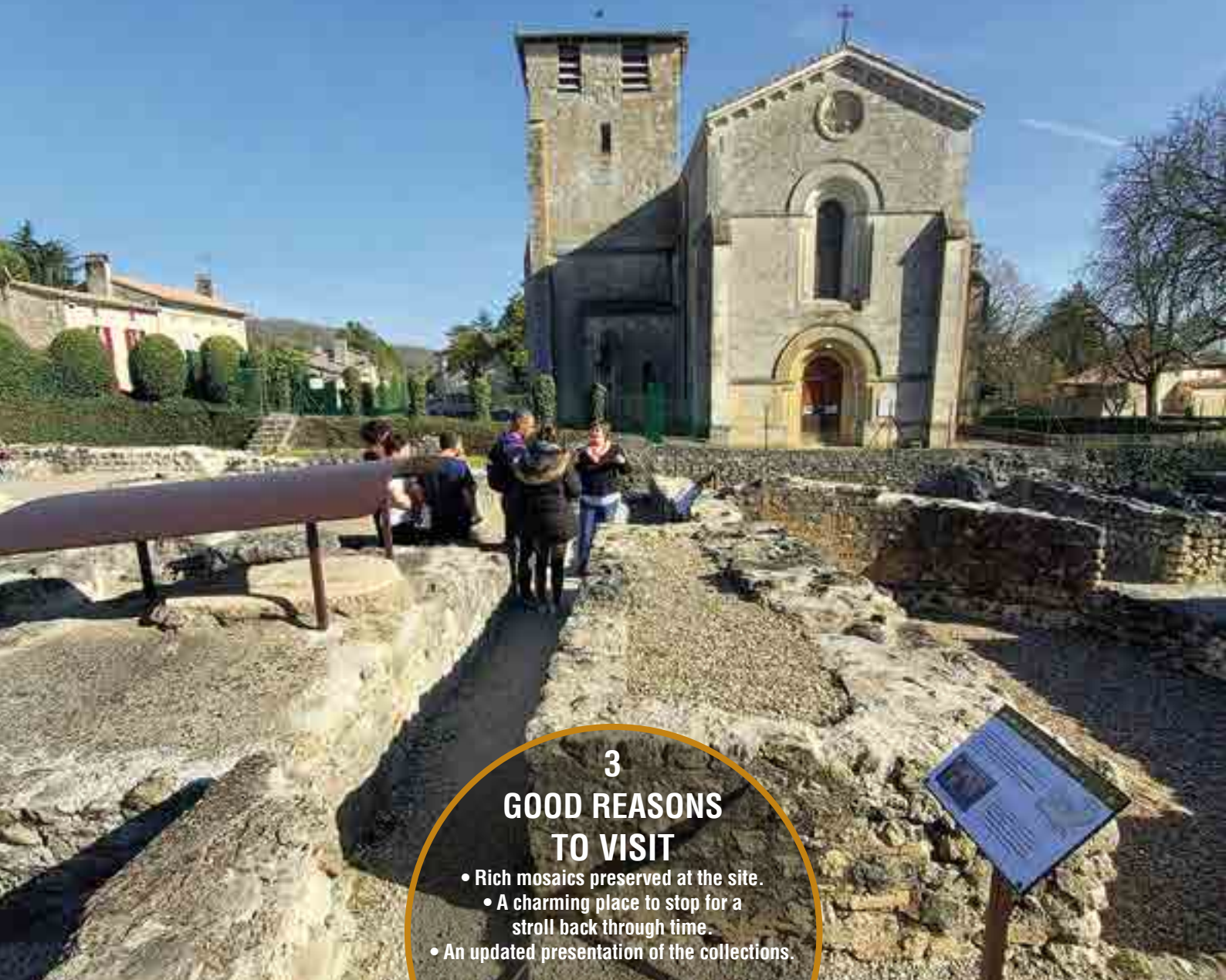




# Gallo-roman villa of **MONTCARET**

Located midway between Saint-Emilion and Bergerac, this Gallo-Roman villa is one of Aquitaine's major archaeological sites, home to both fine remains and rich mosaics.

Some 60 km due east of Bordeaux, between the Bordeaux and Périgord regions, this charming ancient heritage site welcomes visitors to its characteristic seigneurial residence typically inhabited by the elite of the Roman Empire.

### ***DID YOU KNOW...?***

In the Middle Ages, the Romanesque church was built on the foundations of the villa and the cemetery covered the mosaics. Nowadays, the villa adjoins and surrounds the Romanesque church at the heart of the village.
